





# ENGAGEMENT OF APPRENTICES







Central Bank of India, a leading Public Sector Bank, with pan India branch network of more than 4,500 plus branches, with total business of more than Rs 7,00,000 crores, driven by committed work force of more than 33,000 plus employees invites applications from the eligible candidates for the engagement of apprentices, under Apprentices Act, 1961 and as per Apprenticeship policy of the Bank. Central Bank of India, established in 1911 is the first Indian Commercial bank which was wholly owned and managed by Indians. Selected candidates will be engaged in branches/offices in the respective regions at the discretion of the Bank.

The details of the vacancies state-wise are attached as Annexure I

- The number of vacancies/reserved vacancies is tentative and may vary according to the actual requirement of the Bank.
- Candidates belonging to reserved categories are free to apply against vacancies announced for the Unreserved/General category, provided they meet the eligibility criteria laid down for General Category candidates.
- Reservation guidelines as laid down by the Government of India from time to time for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWBD etc. shall be followed.

#### NOTE:

\*\*Medical Fitness, Verification of Documents, Character and caste certificate (wherever applicable) verification of selected candidates:

The engagement of selected candidates will be subject to their being declared medically fit by a duly qualified medical practitioner or subject to production of medical certification from MMBS Doctors or both, as per the discretion of the Bank. Further, engagement will be subject to document verification conducted by the Bank officials and upon satisfactory verification of candidates' character, antecedents and caste validity certificates (wherever applicable). Till such time, their engagement will be provisional.

- a) As the reservation for Physically Challenged persons is on a horizontal basis, the selected candidates will be placed in the appropriate category (viz. SC/ST/OBC/EWS/UR-GEN) to which they belong.
- b) The number of seats for apprentices and the number of reserved seats is provisional and may vary according to the actual requirements of the bank.

#### 1. Eligibility Criteria:

#### **Nationality/Citizenship**

A candidate must be either

- i. a Citizen of India or
- ii. a subject of Nepal or
- iii. a subject of Bhutan or
- iv. a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India or
- v. a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India

Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (ii), (iii), (iv) & (v) above shall be a person in whose favor a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India.

#### Note: -

- 1. Please note that change of category submitted by the applicant will not be permitted at any stage after registration of online application.
- 2. Candidates belonging to OBC category but coming in the 'creamy layer' and/or if their caste does not find place in the Central List are not entitled to OBC reservation and age relaxation. They should indicate their category as "GENERAL" or GENERAL (OC/HI/VI/ID) as applicable.
- 3. Benefit of reservation under EWS category is permissible only upon production of an 'Income and Asset Certificate' issued by a Competent Authority in the format prescribed.
- 4. Caste/EWS/PwBD certificate issued by Competent Authority on format prescribed by the Government of India will have to be submitted by the candidates applying under SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD category, while submitting their application(s).
- 5. The number of training vacancies including reserved vacancies mentioned above are provisional and may vary according to the actual requirement of the bank.
- 6. Reservation for PwBD is horizontal and within the overall training vacancies for the State.
- 7. Candidates seeking age relaxation will be required to submit copies of necessary certificate(s) at the time of selection process and at any subsequent stage of the selection process as required by the Bank.
- 8. Maximum age indicated is for General Category candidates as on 31.05.2025. Relaxation in upper age limit will be available as detailed above.
- 9. Engagement of Apprentices will be subject to his/her being declared medically fit as per the requirement of the Bank.

#### Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities:

Under section 34 of "The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016", persons with benchmark disabilities are eligible for Reservation. The reserved categories of disabilities mentioned under this Act are namely:

- a) Visually Impairment (VI) Blindness and Low Vision.
- b) Hearing Impaired (HI) Deaf and Hard of Hearing.
- c) Orthopedically Challenged (OC) Locomotor Disability (One Arm OA, One Leg -OL, Both Legs BL, One Arm & One Leg -OAL),
- d) Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, Dwarfism, Acid Attack Victims, and Muscular Dystrophy.
- e) Intellectual Disability (ID) Intellectual Disability (Autism Spectrum Disorder, Specific Learning Disability and Mental Illness) & Multiple Disability.
- f) Multiple Disabilities means disability amongst clauses (a) to (d), including deaf blindness in the posts identified for each disability.

The Definition of the above-specified disabilities & allocation of reserved vacancies for persons with benchmark disabilities will be as prescribed in "The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016" and as per the training vacancies advertised.



Note: Only a "person with benchmark disability" would be eligible for reservation with not less than 40% of a specified disability, where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority.

A person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation will have to submit a latest Disability Certificate, on prescribed format, issued by Medical Authority or any other notified Competent Authority (Certifying Authority) in the district of the applicant's residence as mentioned in the proof of residence in the application. The certificate should be dated on or before last date of registration of application. Such certificate shall be subject to verification/re-verification as may be decided by the Board /Competent Authority.

#### **Selection Process: -**

Selection for engagement of candidates who apply for apprenticeship in the Bank after paying requisite online fee shall have to undergo the selection process based on Online Examination to be conducted by BFSI SSC and Test of Local Language of the State.

#### **Online Examination: -**

There will be no negative marks for wrong answers in the Objective tests.

- Selection will be based on merit as per vacancies.
- Merit List is to be drawn depending upon the vacancy.
- In case more than one candidate scores same marks in the Merit List, such candidate will be ranked in the merit list according to their age in descending order.

After the online examination, the result of the candidates who have provisionally qualified for selection will be made available on the Bank's and BFSI SSC's website.

#### **Test of Local Language:**

• The candidates applying for training seats of a particular state, should be proficient (reading, writing, speaking, and understanding) in any one of the specified local languages of that State, as mentioned in the Annexure-II.

**Note:** - Other detailed information regarding the examination process will be given in the "Information Handout", and the same will be made available to all eligible candidates by BFSI SSC.



#### **Final Selection:**

The final selection of the apprentices will be subject to

- Meeting the cut-off marks and being in the merit in the online examination to be decided by the Bank.
- Satisfactory verification of the documents related to Date of Birth/Category/Educational Qualification and other information furnished in the online application.
- Being found Medically Fit as per the requirement of the Bank.

#### **Contract of Apprenticeship:**

Candidates found suitable for engagement based on the merit list after successful document verification shall be issued digital apprenticeship contracts through the government apprenticeship portals, i.e. https://nats.education.gov.in

Candidates shall receive the link for the digital apprenticeship contract from the BFSI SSC and need to accept it on the respective portal(s) within a stipulated time/date as mentioned therein. No candidate shall be engaged as an Apprentice or undergo apprenticeship training in any designated trade/optional trade unless and until he/she enters Contract of Apprenticeship with the Bank and the same is approved by the Authorities of the respective Portals.

#### **Duration of training:**

The duration of training is period of twelve months. The apprentices shall be imparted training on different aspects of banking practices, products and processes.

#### **Stipend/Benefits:**

The apprentices are eligible for a stipend of Rs 15,000/- per month for the engagement period of one year. The apprentices are not eligible for any other allowances/benefits.

#### **Assessment and Certification:**

After the completion of apprenticeship training, apprentices may need to go through an assessment test. The certificate will be awarded as per prevailing guidelines.

#### **Termination of Apprenticeship Contract:**

- The Contract of Apprenticeship shall be annulled if the apprentice does not report at the Bank's Training venue / Bank Branch on the date of commencement of On-Job-Training.
- The Contract of Apprenticeship shall automatically terminate on expiry of the period of Apprenticeship Training.
- The Bank or the Apprentice can make an application to the Apprenticeship Advisor for the termination of the contract before the completion of the apprenticeship period, stating clearly the reason for termination.
- Apprenticeship Advisor (BFSI SSC) may, by order in writing, terminate the contract if he is satisfied that the
  apprentice or the Bank has failed to carry out the terms and conditions of the contract.
- Provided that where a contract is terminated-
  - For failure on the part of Bank to carry out the terms and conditions of the contract, the Bank shall pay to the apprentice such compensation as determined by the Apprenticeship Advisor; For such failure on the part of apprentice, the apprentice shall refund the Bank as cost of training such amount as may be determined by the Apprenticeship Advisor.



The bank can terminate the contract of an apprentice due to misconduct by the apprentice, with or without a notice.

#### **Conduct and Discipline:**

As per Section 17 of the Apprentices Act, 1961, amended from time to time, in all matters of Conduct and Discipline, the apprentice shall be governed by the 'Rules and procedure for disciplinary action against Workmen' of the Central Bank of India.

#### Application Fees/Intimation Charges (Non-Refundable)

Application/Examination/Intimation fee to be remitted by all eligible applicants to the scrutinizing/examining body deputed by the Bank is as under (GST @ 18% extra will be charged on application fee):

Candidates can make the payment of requisite fees/intimation charges through the ONLINE mode only and no other mode of payment is acceptable:

Fee/ Intimation charges once paid will NOT be refunded on any account nor can it be held in reserve for any other exam or selection.

#### **Other Terms and Conditions:**

The Candidate should NOT have undergone Apprenticeship either in Central Bank of India or in any other organization/establishment earlier or be pursuing Apprenticeship Training as per the Apprentices Act 1961 as amended from time to time.

The training duration/apprenticeship or engagement period shall be 12 months, and Govt of India Guidelines will be followed for leave, working conditions, and holidays.

Candidates who had training or job experience for one year or more after the attainment of the educational qualifications, shall NOT be eligible for being engaged as Apprentices.

No Ex-servicemen / Disabled Ex-Servicemen shall be engaged as an apprentice, and there is no reservation for ex-servicemen/ Disabled ex-servicemen in the apprentice engagement.

The apprentice shall have no right to claim employment in the Bank after completion of training.

The Bank shall have no obligation to offer regular employment to Apprentices during and/or after the completion of the apprenticeship period. After completion of the apprenticeship period, candidates will be relieved from the respective work area. The Apprentices engaged by the Bank will not be provided with any Transport / Hostel facility or any other form of residential accommodation during Apprentice training



Every apprentice undergoing apprenticeship training in the Bank shall be a TRAINEE for all purposes and not considered as a WORKER or EMPLOYEE of the Bank; as such, the provisions of any law concerning labour shall not apply to or about such apprentice.

The apprentices will not be entitled to receive any benefits that are available for the employees of the Bank.

The bank has the right to cancel the engagement of the apprentices engaged at any point in time without prior notice, in case of any misconduct by the apprentice during the engagement period.

The Apprentices are prohibited from joining/forming any Union Body.

Any dispute arising out of this advertisement for the engagement of apprentices will be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts in **Mumbai**.

The process of application is complete only when the fee is deposited, through online mode, on or before the last date of payment of the fee. Candidates are advised to check the Bank's website regularly for details and updates. No separate intimation/advertisement, etc. will be issued in case of any change/update.

The Bank decision will be final and binding on all candidates on all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of applications, mode of selection, and cancellation of the selection process either in part or in full, etc.

No correspondence will be entertained in this regard. Filling up of the seats is solely at the discretion of the Bank based on the suitability of candidates, and no claim can be made for engagement if some of these seats are not filled due to unsuitability / insufficient number of candidates.

The incomplete Online applications shall not be considered as "Eligible" and treated as "Rejected". No communication will be entertained in this regard.

Candidates should satisfy themselves about their eligibility before applying for engagement as apprentice in the Bank.

Not more than one application should be submitted by a candidate. In case of multiple applications, only the last valid (completed) application will be retained, and the application fee/ intimation charge paid for other registration will stand forfeited. Multiple attendance/appearance by a candidate in the examination will be summarily rejected/candidature will be cancelled.

The possibility for occurrence of some problems in the administration of the examination cannot be ruled out completely, which may impact test delivery and/or result from being generated. In that event, every effort will be made to rectify such a problem, which may include the conduct of another examination if considered necessary.

Candidates are advised to take a printout of their system-generated online application form after applying.

Candidates are advised to keep their registered e-mail ID/mobile active for receiving instructions if any, viz. call letters/notifications, etc.

Engagement of selected candidates is subject to his/her being declared medically fit as per the requirement of the Bank and such engagement will also be subject to all relevant rules/policies/guidelines of the Bank.

Any legal proceedings in respect of any matter of claim or dispute arising out of this advertisement and/or an application in response thereto can be instituted only in Mumbai, and Courts/Tribunals/Forums at Mumbai only shall have sole and exclusive jurisdiction to try any cause/dispute.



The candidates will have to appear for the selection process at their own cost. Central Bank of India will not pay or reimburse any such expenses.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR FILLING ONLINE APPLICATION:**

Candidates can apply online, and no other mode of application will be accepted.

Candidates should mandatorily first register themselves, if eligible, in the apprenticeship portals of Government of India viz NATS portal *https://nats.education.gov.in* (Navigate to the "Student Register/Login" section)

In case the candidates are facing issues in getting themselves registered they are advised to go through the help manual available on the respective apprenticeship portals. For NATS portal refer to "Candidate User Manual" on <a href="https://nats.education.gov.in/assets/manual/student manual.pdf">https://nats.education.gov.in/assets/manual/student manual.pdf</a>

All candidates are supposed to remember their respective login id and passwords of the apprenticeship portals as applicable to them, as they will be repetitively visiting the apprenticeship portals for various activities till their completion of the apprenticeship program

For NATS portal, candidates can view the Apprenticeship Advertisement of "Central Bank of India" after login into the portal by visiting <a href="https://nats.education.gov.in/student\_type.php">https://nats.education.gov.in/student\_type.php</a>.

It is very IMPORTANT for all candidates who have applied to MAKE NOTE of their Enrolment Id (issued by NATS portal) for all the future correspondence.

All Candidates who have applied successfully for the Apprenticeship Opportunity/Advertisement on NATS will receive an email from BFSI SSC (info@bfsissc.com) inviting them to give required details about the caste category, choice of districts for their training, etc. and make the payment of the Application Fees.

Candidates should scan their photograph, signature & documents as detailed under guidelines for respective apprenticeship portals.

Candidates are advised to carefully fill in the online application themselves as no change in any of the data filled in the online application will be possible/ entertained at a later stage. Prior to submission of the online application, candidates are advised to verify the details in the online application form and modify the same if required.

No change is permitted after clicking on SUBMIT button. Visually Impaired candidates will be responsible for getting the details filled in/carefully verifying, in the online application and ensuring that the same are correct prior to submission as no change is possible after submission. ix.

The name of the candidate should be spelt correctly in the application as it appears in the certificates/ mark sheets. Any change/ alteration found may disqualify the candidature.

An online application which is incomplete in any respect and unsuccessful Application fee payment will not be considered as valid.

Candidates shall also be required to submit supporting documents such as Date of Birth Proof, Graduation/Mandatory Qualification Certificate/s, Other Certifications, etc. at the time of registering on the apprenticeship portals or as and when advised by the Bank or BFSI SSC



Candidates are advised in their own interest to apply online much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection / inability / failure to log on to the website on account of heavy load on internet or website.

Central Bank of India does not assume any responsibility for the candidates not being able to submit their applications within the last date on account of aforesaid reasons or for any other reason beyond the control of Central Bank of India

Please note that all the particulars mentioned in the online application including Name of the Candidate, Category, Date of Birth, Address, Mobile Number, Email ID, Centre of Examination, etc. will be considered as final and no change/modifications will be allowed after submission of the online application form.

#### ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:

- 1.1 Candidates are advised in their own interest that they should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered, fabricated or should not suppress any material information while filling up the application form.
- 1.2 At the time of Examination, if a candidate is/has been found guilty of:
  - using unfair means during the examination or
  - impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or
  - misbehaving during the examination or disclosing, publishing, reproducing, transmitting, storing or facilitating transmission and storage of contents of the test(s) or any information therein in whole or part thereof in any form or by any means, verbal or written, electronically or mechanically for any purpose
  - resorting to any irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for selection or obtaining support for his/her candidature by any means, such a candidate may in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable:
    - (a) to be disqualified from the examination for which he/she is a candidate
    - (b) to be debarred, either permanently or for a specified period, from any examination or recruitment conducted by the Bank
    - (c) For termination from the apprenticeship training, if he/she has already joined the apprenticeship training of the Bank.

Important: The test conducting agency, would be analysing the responses (answers) of individual candidates with other candidates to detect patterns of similarity of right and wrong answers. If in the analytical procedure adopted by test conducting agency in this regard, it is inferred/ concluded that the responses have been shared and scores obtained are not genuine/ valid, in such cases Bank reserves the right to cancel the candidature of the concerned candidates and the result of such candidates (disqualified) will be withheld.

#### **Intimation for Online Test/ Document Verification / Language Test:**

Candidates who register successfully, would receive an email communication from the Bank/ BFSI SSC (info@bfsissc.com), regarding online examination date & time and the process to be followed. No Hard Copy of The Intimation Letter for Online Examination will Be sent by Post.



After completion of the online examination, intimation will be sent through E-mail to the qualified candidates to report at Central Bank of India Regional / Zonal Office for undergoing Document verification, Language Proficiency Test and other selection process, if any.

Bank will not take responsibility for late receipt/ non-receipt of any communication sent via e-mail to the candidate due to change of email address, technical fault or otherwise beyond the control of the Bank.

List of all candidates who qualify the written test and the list of finally selected candidates will be published on career page of Banks website and https://bfsissc.com. Also, the shortlisted and selected candidates will receive an email communication from BFSI SSC guiding them on further action to be taken on the respective apprenticeship portals.

Candidates are hence advised to regularly keep in touch with the authorized websites of the Bank and BFSI SSC for details, updates and any information which may be posted for further guidance. Candidates are also advised to check their registered e-mail account from time to time during the selection process for any update. Any request for change of centre, date and time for online examination or Language Test shall not be entertained.

#### List of Documents to be produced at the time of Document Verification / Language Proficiency Test:

The following documents in original together with a self-attested photocopy in support of the candidate's eligibility and identity are to be invariably submitted at the time of Language Test failing which the candidate will not be permitted to appear for the Language Test. Non submission of requisite documents by the candidate at the time of Language Test will debar his candidature from further participation in the selection process.

Valid system generated printout of the online application/Registration/ Enrolment form.

Proof of Date of Birth (DOB) (Birth Certificate issued by the Competent Municipal Authority or SSLC/ Std. X Certificate with DOB). Photo Identify Proof as indicated above.

Individual Semester/Year wise Marksheets & certificates for educational qualifications including the final degree/diploma certificate. Proper document from Board/University for having declared the result has to be submitted.

Candidate should indicate the percentage obtained in SSC/HSC/Graduate/Post-Graduate/Diploma examination calculated to the two decimals in the online application. Where CGPA/OGPA is awarded, the same should be converted into percentage and indicated in the online application. If called for interaction/document verification, the candidate will have to produce a certificate issued by the appropriate authority inter-alia stating the norms of the University / Board regarding conversion of grade into percentage and the percentage of marks scored by the candidate in terms of these norms.

Caste Certificate issued by competent authority, strictly in the prescribed format as stipulated by Government of India, in case of SC/ ST/OBC/EWS category candidates. (as enclosed in the Annexure).

In case of candidates belonging to OBC category, certificate should specifically contain a clause that the candidate does not belong to creamy layer section excluded from the benefits of reservation for Other Backward Classes in Civil post & services under Government of India. OBC caste certificate containing the non-creamy layer clause should be valid as on the date of Language Test if called for (issued within one year as on the date of advertisement). Caste Name mentioned in certificate should tally letter by letter with Central Government list / notification.

Disability certificate in prescribed format issued by the District Medical Board in case of Persons with Benchmark Disability category. If the candidate has used the services of a Scribe at the time of online examination, then the duly filled in details of the scribe in the prescribed format.



Any other relevant documents in support of eligibility.

The Competent Authority for the issue of the certificate to SC / ST / OBC /EWS/ PERSONS WITH BENCHMARK DISABILITIES is as under (as notified by GOI from time to time):




